- Jesus healed a demon-possessed boy (9:14-32)
  - Jesus rebuked the people for their unbelief (9:19-23)
  - Three lessons about faith:
    - ✓ Biblical faith requires knowing and believing the truth about God (9:23)
    - ✓ We need God's power to believe (9:24)
    - ✓ Failure to turn to God for help results in powerlessness and confusion (9:25-32)
- Jesus taught His disciples about relationships with others (9:33-50)
  - Greatness comes through serving (9:33-37)
  - Don't judge those outside your group who genuinely serve in Jesus' name (9:38-41)
  - Don't influence other believers to sin (9:42-50)
